Mr. Curtis H. Chappell is Director of Security for Thales Defense & Security, Inc. (TDSI) headquartered in the Washington, DC metro area, managing all aspects of corporate security including NISPOM, Physical Security, Insider Threat, and Foreign Ownership, Control or Influence (FOCI) compliance programs. TDSI, a Thales company, is a global service provider for the defense, federal, and commercial markets with innovative solutions for the ground tactical, airborne and avionics, naval/maritime, and security domains. In addition to mission-critical, multi-band communication systems, TDSI provides: SATCOM terminals; helmet-mounted displays and motion tracking technologies; advanced sonar systems; air traffic management; navigation, surveillance, and simulation; and digital security services including biometric identification, data encryption and protection solutions.

TDSI, a FOCI-mitigated company operating under a Proxy Agreement, is a subsidiary of Thales S.A., a global aerospace defense and technology solution provider. Thales Group has over 64,000 employees in 56 countries that design and build systems and provide services for the aerospace, transportation, defense, and security markets. TDSI serves as a technology gateway leveraging Thales-wide technologies and solutions to address U.S. requirements; 99% of commercial aircraft in the U.S. are safely guided to their destination by Thales navigation systems. With over 25,000 engineers and researchers, Thales has a unique capability to design and deploy equipment, systems and services to meet the most complex communications and security requirements. TDSI is one of the longest-standing FOCI companies operating in the U.S., signing its original Proxy with the Department of Defense in 1986.
